



## 2008 Zinfandel – Sonoma County

A lush, delicious and “serious” wine but in a fun package! The nose is fruit driven with fresh plum, bing cherry, spicy peppercorn and zinberry. The mouthfeel is soft with a hint of milk chocolate, sweet oak, and a long vanilla finish. The deep color and firm structure are enhanced by the addition of the Petite Sirah and the firm tannins softened by moderate oak. Enjoy this *POIZIN* with caution; it is *The Wine to Die for!*

*Harvest Dates:* Multiple vineyards - from the end of September through October 20<sup>th</sup>.

*Grape Varieties:* 75% Zinfandel, 21% Petite Sirah, 4% Syrah

*Barrel Aging:* 11 Months in 2/3 American Oak and 1/3 French Oak

*Percentage of New Oak:* 30%

*Alcohol:* 14.5%
