Tre Torrente vineyard sits on the eastern ridge of Dry Creek Valley. The unique bowl shape of this property creates unusual variety within the vineyard and we are blessed with a plethora of flavor profiles during harvest. This wine entices the senses with loads of fresh fruit, cranberry, blackberries, and bing cherry. Sweet vanilla oak, sasparrilla, and other spices finish out this hearty and well balanced wine.
